



Lot Sizes, Fire Separation Distances, and Setback Requirements for Manufactured Home Parks

Minimum Lot Sizes

Paragraphs (A), (B), and (C) of O.A.C. 4781-12-08

- Park constructed or substantially altered on or between 12/17/1951 to 12/31/1960 and not substantially altered after 12/31/1960:
 - 1,250 square feet
- Park constructed or substantially altered on or between 1/1/1961 and 6/30/1971 and not substantially altered after 6/30/1971:
 - 1,800 square feet
- Park constructed or substantially altered on or after 7/1/1971:
 - 3,600 square feet

Minimum Fire Separation Distances

Paragraphs (E) and (G) of O.A.C. 4781-12-08

- Park constructed on or before 12/31/1960 and not substantially altered after 6/30/1971:
 - 10 feet between sides of manufactured homes
 - 8 feet between the end of any manufactured home and a side of any manufactured home
 - 5 feet between the ends of manufactured homes placed end to end
- Park constructed after 12/31/1960 or substantially altered after 6/30/1971:
 - Manufactured homes placed side to side or at an angle less than 90 degrees:
 - Average of 15 feet, with no distance less than 12 feet at any point
 - Manufactured homes placed side to end or at an angle equal to or greater than 90 degrees, but less than 135 degrees:
 - 10 feet
 - Manufactured homes placed end to end or at an angle equal to or greater than 135 degrees:
 - 5 feet

Minimum Setbacks

Paragraphs (F) and (H) of O.A.C. 4781-12-08

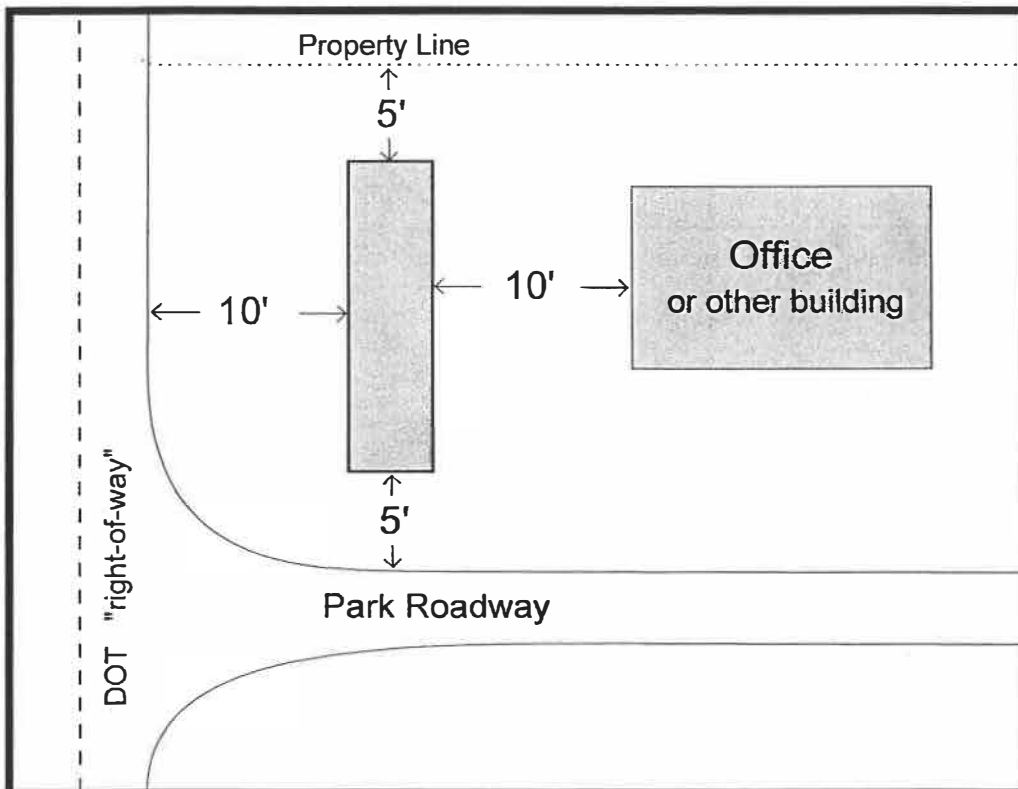
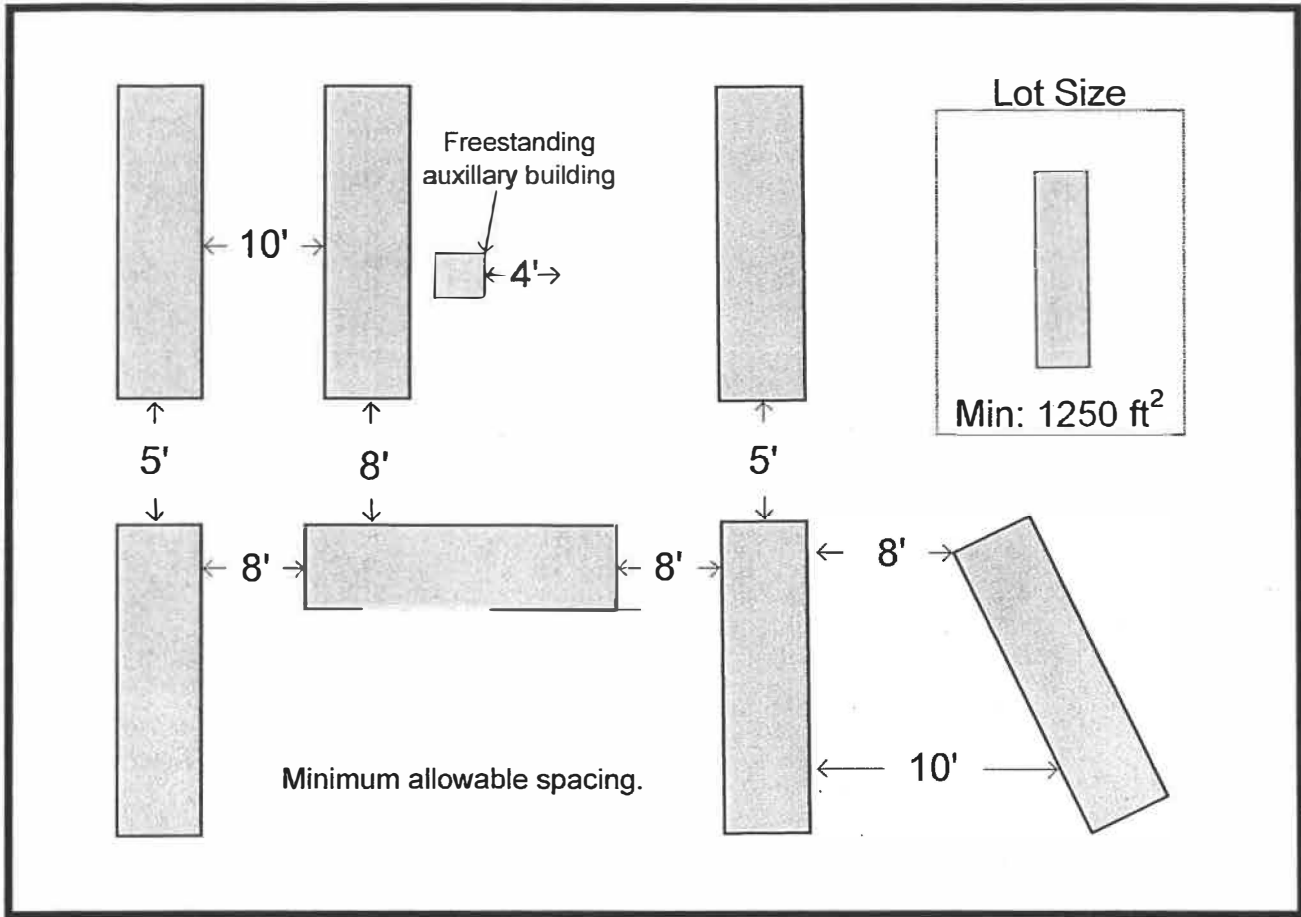
- Park constructed on or before and not substantially altered after 6/30/1971:
 - 10 feet between a manufactured home and any building, public roadway, street, alley, and any right-of-way designated by the Ohio Department of Transportation or local jurisdiction
 - 5 feet between a manufactured home and any park roadway, parkway, and the manufactured home park property line
- Park constructed or substantially altered after 6/30/1971:
 - 15 feet between a manufactured home and any building, public roadway, street, alley, and any right-of-way designated by the Ohio Department of Transportation or local jurisdiction
 - 10 feet between a manufactured home and any park roadway, parkway, and the manufactured home park property line

Freestanding Auxiliary Buildings

O.A.C. 4781-12-08.1

- Maximum of 2 freestanding auxiliary buildings per manufactured home lot
- Park established before 1961:
 - 4 feet minimum distance between a freestanding auxiliary building and occupied manufactured home (*so long as the placement does not violate local, state, or federal law)
- Park established in or after 1961:
 - 5 feet minimum distance between a freestanding auxiliary building and occupied manufactured home

Manufactured home parks built before and not substantially altered after December 31, 1960



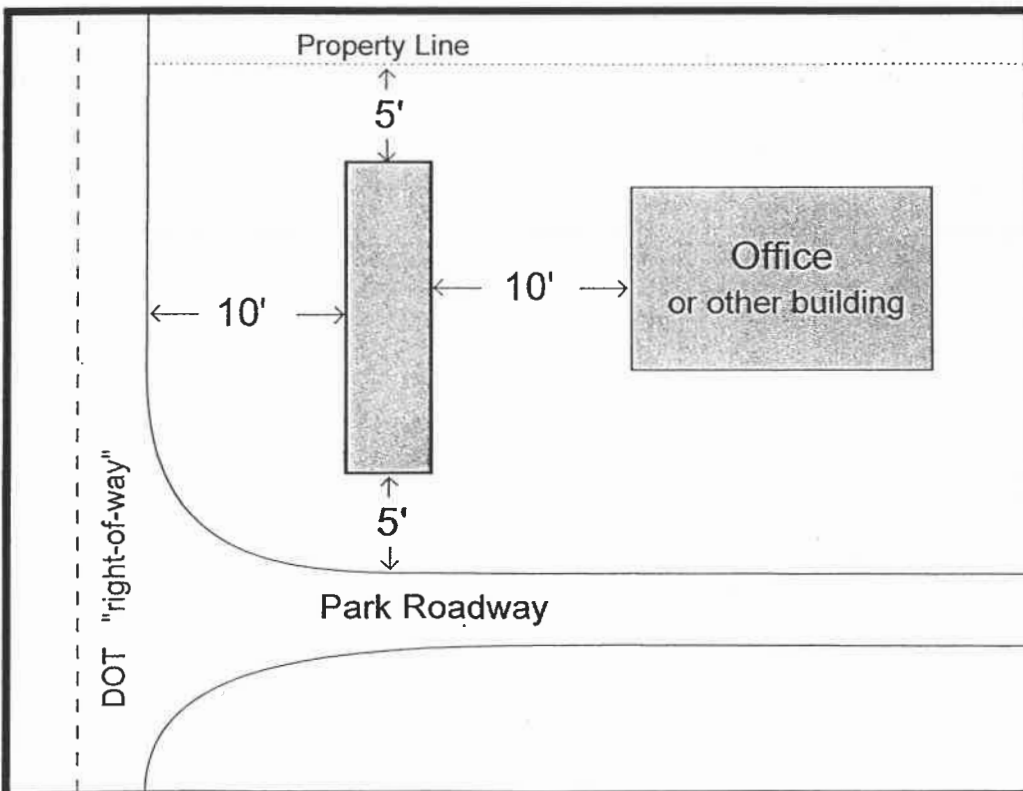
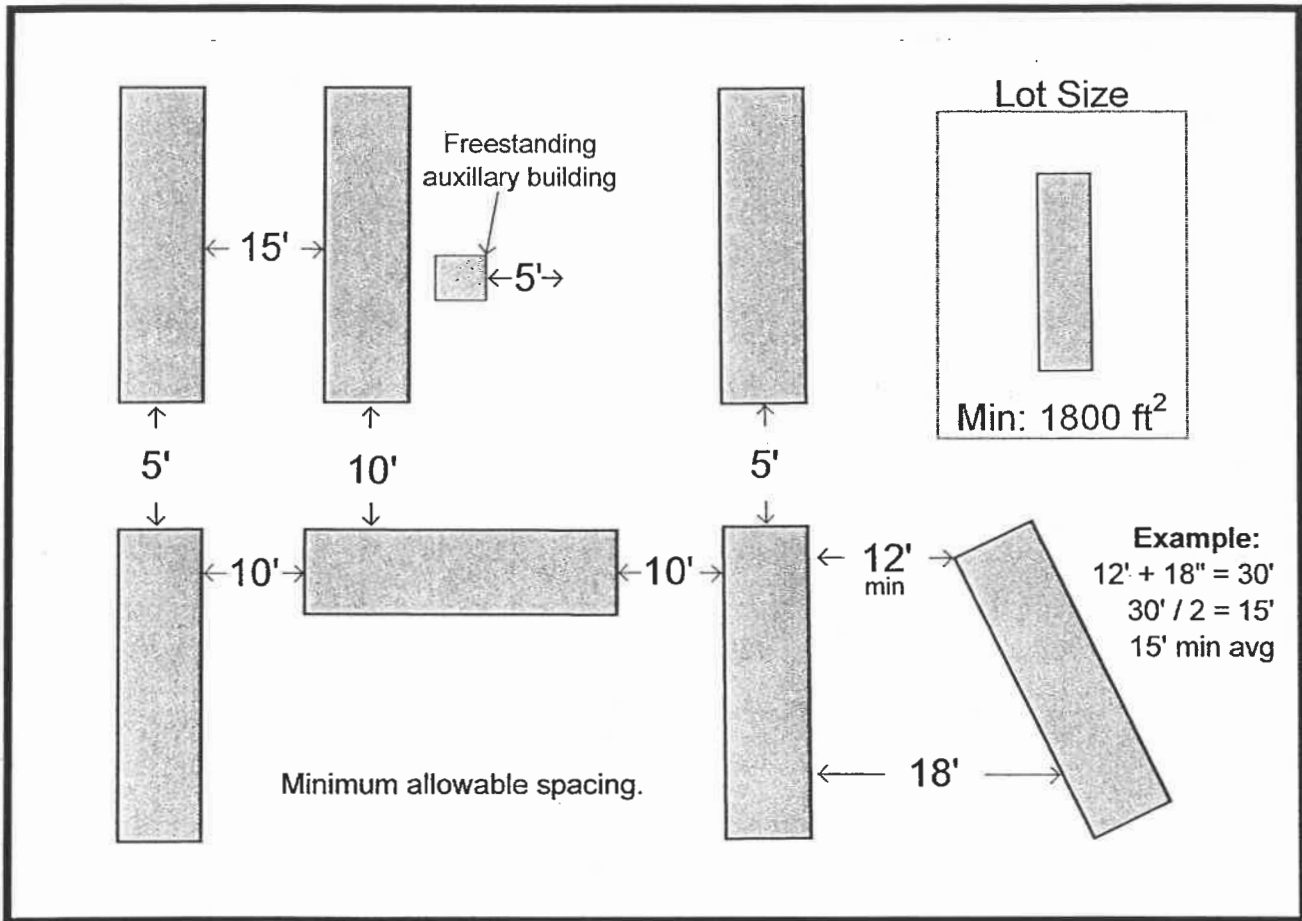

Manufactured home parks built or substantially altered between Jan. 1, 1961 and June 30, 1971 (and not substantially altered after June 30, 1971)



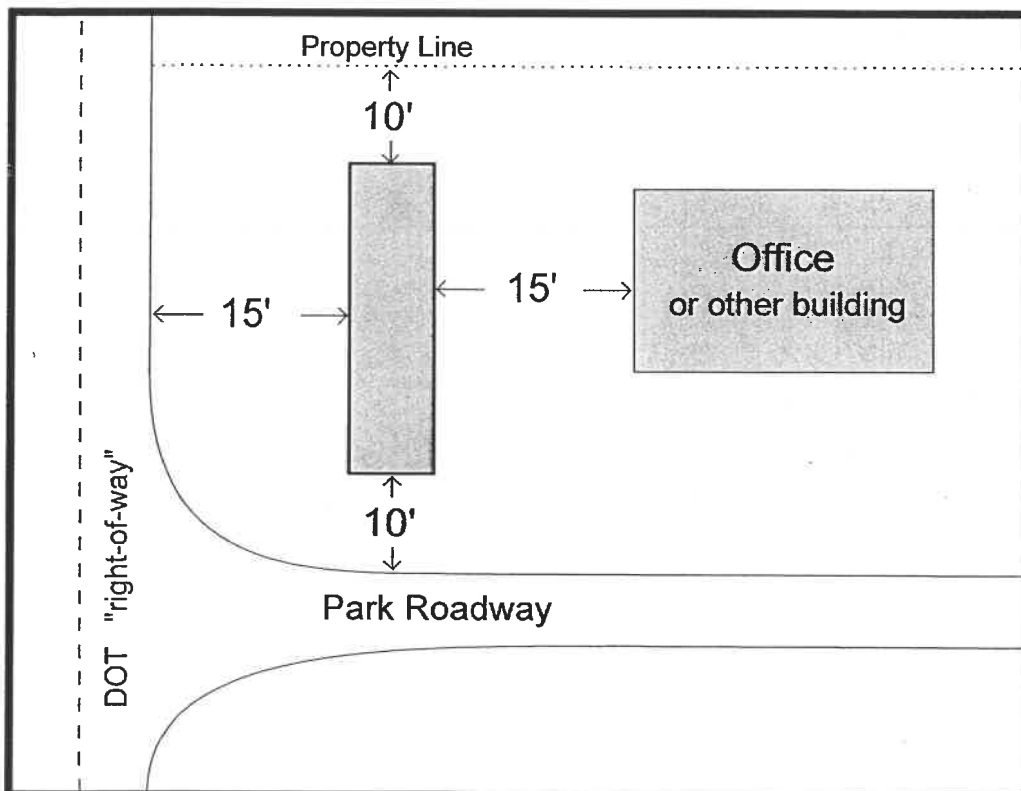
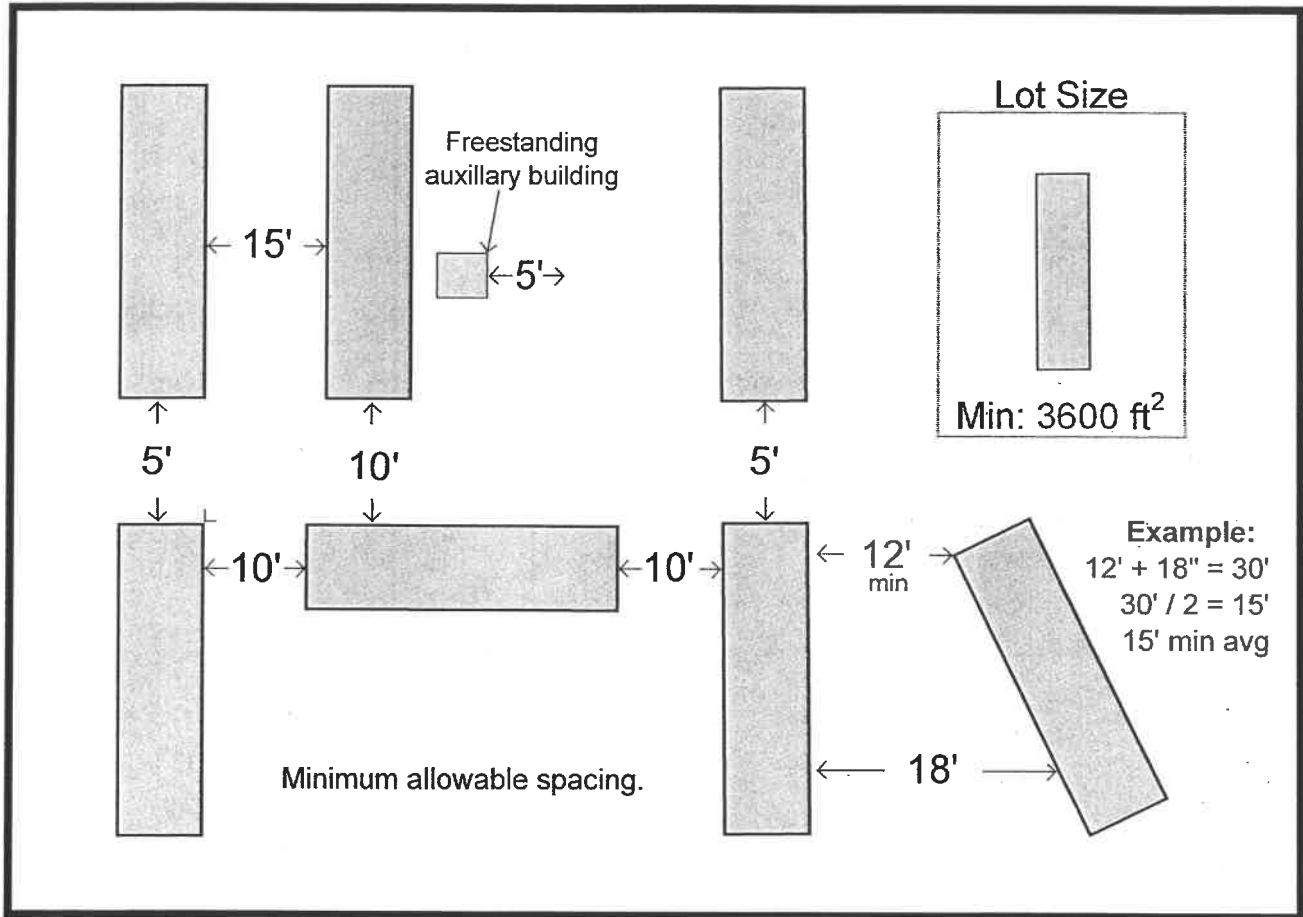
Lot Size - O.A.C. 4781-12-08(B)
